Course Number and Title: PCL1300H: Selected Topics in Clinical Pharmacology and Toxicology

Course Description:

This graduate course for students registered in the Applied Clinical Pharmacology (ACP) MSc field of study has a modular design and aims to raise awareness about and preparedness for careers related to the application of clinical pharmacology. Topics explore personal and professional career development with a variety of guest speakers from the pharmaceutical and biotech industries, contract research organizations (CROs), government, and medical communications and business consulting agencies.

Course Schedule: Classes are generally held on Fridays from 1:00 to 3:00 p.m. (Fall

Term) and Wednesdays from 1 to 3 p.m. (Winter Term)

Grade written and oral course assignments, conduct regular meetings with students to discuss career development and review course assignments.
